1321 SPRINGHILL ROAD ~43,000 SQUARE FEET OF CANNABIS (1 ACRE)

- Four -2,500 sq. ft. greenhouses, Wholesale Nursery with processing (drying and trimming) on a 16 acre property nestled in a residential area.
- Less than a mile (0.73) from Spring Hill Montessori Elementary Campus.

334 PURVINE ROAD ~43,000 SQUARE FEET OF CANNABIS (1 ACRE)

- Commercial cannabis cultivation, up to 10,000 sq. ft. small mixed light, 5,000 sq. ft. specialty indoor, and 28,500 sq. ft. outdoor cultivation, on 37.02 acres in a rural-residential neighborhood.
- 300-foot setback from neighbors' windows.
- Guard Station with 24-hour guardsmen and video surveillance.
- Funded by BigRock, an SF-based venture capitalist investing firm

7610 VALLEY FORD ROAD ~43,000 SQUARE FEET OF CANNABIS (1 ACRE)

- Commercial cannabis cultivation with 33,560 square feet of outdoor cultivation and 10,000 square feet of small mixed light cultivation.
- 8,000 square feet of processing and propagation.

3215 MIDDLE TWO ROCK ROAD ~43,000 SQUARE FEET OF CANNABIS (1 ACRE)

- Commercial cannabis cultivation, 10,000 sq. ft. mixed light plus up to 1 acre outdoor on Nadale Ranch.
- 1.5 miles from Wilson Elementary School.

6095 BODEGA AVENUE 10,000 SQUARE FEET OF CANNABIS

- 10,000 sq. ft. mixed light cultivation on a 7-acre property.
- Appear to already be growing in non-compliance (100-feet from neighbors' windows).

WATER USAGE

Estimates range between 200,000 and 2 MILLION gallons of water annually for every acre of cannabis cultivation.

SAFETY

Captain Mark Essick stated publicly that 7 of the last 10 homicides in Sonoma County were marijuana related.
